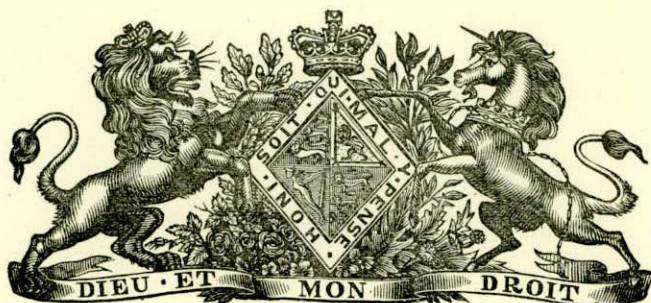

An Act to repeal the "Agreements Validating Act," and to make provision for continuance of agreements lawfully made thereunder before the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three.

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5 1. On and from the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, the "Agreements Validating Act," being the Act of the thirty-ninth Victoria number twenty-nine, shall be repealed: Provided that notwithstanding such repeal every agreement lawfully entered into pursuant to the said Act before the
- 10 first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, shall have the like validity and binding force on the parties thereto, and shall be accompanied by the like rights and remedies for all purposes, as if this Act had not been passed.
