An Act to declare the meaning of the words "the publication of the Report of the said Board" as used in the forty-third section of the Crown Lands Act of 1889. [Assented to, 5th June, 1894.]

THEREAS the forty-third section of the Crown Lands Act of Preamble. 1889 contains a provision allowing thirty days from the date of "the publication of the Report of the said Board" for the withdrawal of applications for the extension of certain leases: And whereas doubts have arisen as to the date indicated and referred to in the said provision, and it is expedient to now set such doubts at rest: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

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
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
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
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
