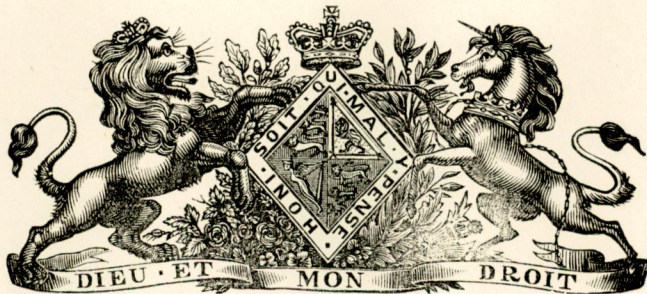

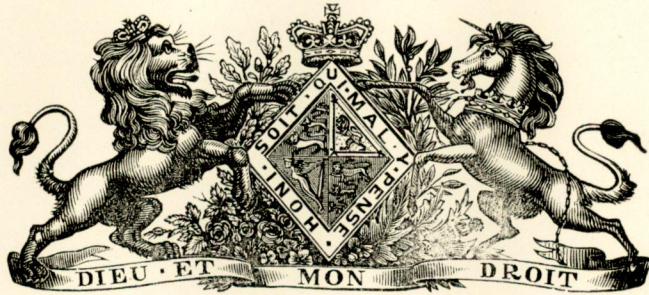

An Act to amend the *Water Supply Acts*, 1852 to 1881.

Enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this behalf assembled, and by the authority of the same, that the following provisions shall have effect...

Section 1. The Board of Water Supply for the City of London, established by the *Water Supply Act*, 1852, shall continue to exist, and shall have the same powers and authorities as are conferred upon them by that Act and the Acts amending the same, and shall be subject to the same provisions as to the appointment and removal of members, and to the mode of election of members, as are contained in the said Act and the Acts amending the same.

Section 2. The Board of Water Supply for the City of London shall have power to borrow money, and to take and dispose of land, and to do all such other things as may be necessary for the purposes of the Acts mentioned in the title hereof, and to do all such other things as may be necessary for the purposes of the Acts mentioned in the title hereof.

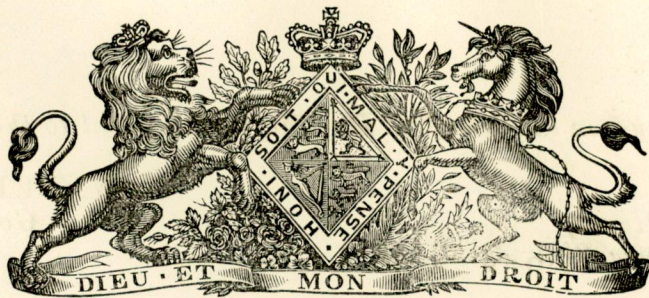
Section 3. The Board of Water Supply for the City of London shall be subject to the same provisions as to the appointment and removal of members, and to the mode of election of members, as are contained in the *Water Supply Act*, 1852, and the Acts amending the same.

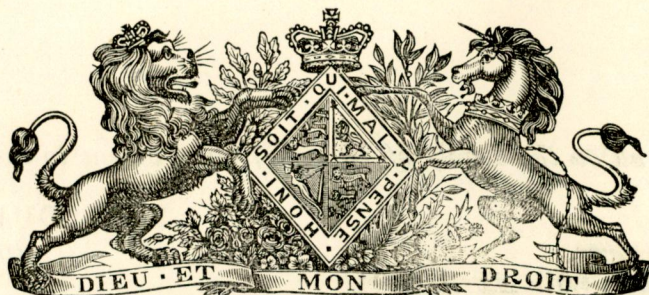

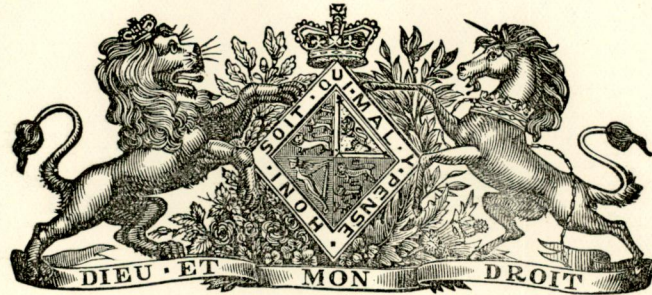

An Act to amend the Water Supply Act of 1882.

Enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the House of Representatives of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the said Majesty:—
