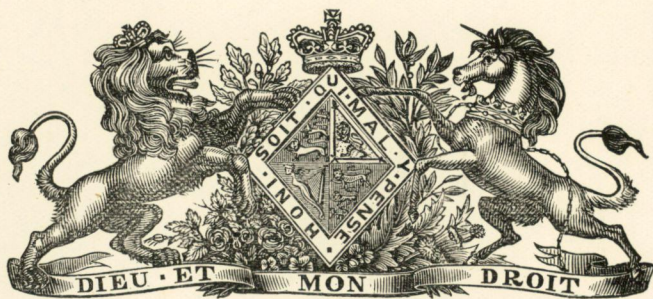

An Act to amend the Armidale Water Supply Works Act, 1894.
[Assented to, 21st March, 1895.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. So much of section one of the Armidale Water Supply Works Act, 1894, as refers to the plan of the work the carrying out of which is thereby sanctioned, is hereby amended, and the plan there referred to shall be deemed to be the plan marked "Armidale Water Supply Works (No. 2)" signed by the Secretary for Public Works and countersigned by the Engineer-in-Chief for Harbours and Rivers, and deposited in the office of the said Secretary. Amendment of section 1 as to plan.

2. Section two of the said Act is hereby amended by substituting the words "thirty-five thousand pounds" for the words "forty-three thousand five hundred pounds" in that section. Amendment of section 2 as to estimate.

3. The Schedule to the said Act is hereby repealed, and in the place of the said Schedule the words in the Schedule to this Act are hereby substituted. Schedule substituted for that in Act amended.

4. This Act may be cited as the "Armidale Water Supply Works Act Amendment Act, 1895." Short title.

SCHEDULE.

Water Supply for the town of Armidale, county of Sandon, parish of Armidale.

The proposed works are shown by red lines on the plan referred to in section one of this Act. They consist of:—

1. A concrete dam, five hundred and eighty feet in length and thirty-four feet in height, across the Dumaresq Creek, to form a storage reservoir.
2. A concrete service reservoir, seventy-five feet in diameter and fifteen feet deep.
3. About eight and a half miles of nine-inch steel pipes, from the storage reservoir to the service reservoir.
4. About sixteen miles of six-inch, four-inch, and three-inch reticulation pipes, with hydrants, &c.

1. In section one of the *Amalgamated Water Supply Works Act, 1894*, as far as the plan of the work the carrying out of which is thereby authorized is hereby amended, and the plan there referred to shall be deemed to be the plan marked "Amalgamated Water Supply Works (No. 1)" signed by the Secretary for Public Works and countersigned by the Engineer-in-Chief for Rivers and Docks, and deposited in the office of the said Secretary.

2. Section two of the said Act is hereby amended by substituting the words "thirty-two thousand pounds" for the words "forty-three thousand five hundred pounds" in that section.

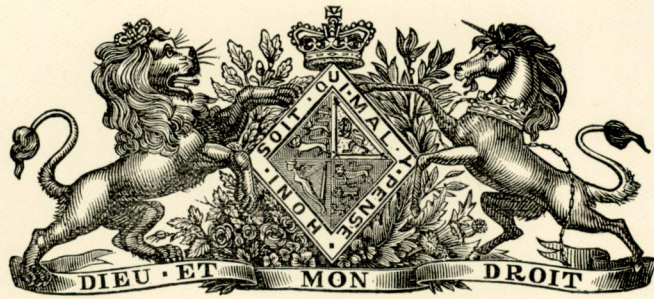
3. The schedule to the said Act is hereby repealed, and in the place of the said schedule the words in the schedule to this Act are hereby substituted.
