This PUBLIC BILL originated in the LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, and, having this day passed, is now ready for presentation to the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL for its concurrence.

An Act relating to Vine Diseases; to prevent the introduction into this Colony, or removal from place to place in this Colony, of diseased grapes or grape vines, or any other matter or thing which may injuriously affect any grape vine or vineyard; and to eradicate the disease known as Phylloxera vastatrix affecting grapes, grape vines, or vineyards; to quarantine, and if necessary destroy any grapes, grape vine, vineyard, package, or implement; to appoint a Central Board; and for other purposes incidental thereto; and to repeal the Act 56 Victoria No. 22.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Levieldt the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the "Vine Diseases Act of 1895," Short title and 5 and shall come into operation on the first day of June, one thousand commencement. eight hundred and ninety-five.

2. The Act fifty-sixth Victoria number twenty-two is hereby Repeal. repealed; but such repeal shall not affect any proclamation, appoint-10 ment, regulation, or order made, or notice, notification, or authority

given, or any compensation due or payable, or proceedings begun, under the said Act before the commencement of this Act.
