An Act to repeal the Acts eighteenth Victoria number twentythree and thirty-ninth Victoria number eleven, and to vest certain lands and chattels in Her Majesty. [Assented to, 6th December, 1897.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled,

and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Acts eighteenth Victoria number twenty-three and Repeal of 18 Vic. thirty-ninth Victoria number eleven are hereby repealed, but the said No. 23 and 39 Vic. No. 11. repeal shall not affect any conviction had or proceeding taken before the passing of this Act.

2. All the right, title, interest, and property of the Commis-Lands and chattels sioners for the time being in the said Acts mentioned to or in any wested in Her Majesty. lands or chattels vested in the said Commissioners by or under the authority of the said Acts, or either of them, are hereby vested in Her Majesty absolutely, free from all trusts, liabilities, charges, and conditions whatever; and notwithstanding such Acts, or any setting apart or dedication, the lands within the town of Campbelltown

hereinafter described in Schedules A and B shall, together with such parts of Stewart and Dumeresque streets as are included in the descriptions in such Schedules be deemed to be, and may be dealt with as "Crown Lands" within the meaning of the Crown Lands Acts at present in force or any Acts which may amend the same, and any such setting apart or dedication shall be deemed by this Act to have been revoked.

3. This Act may be cited as the "Campbelltown Reservoir Acts Repeal Act of 1897."
