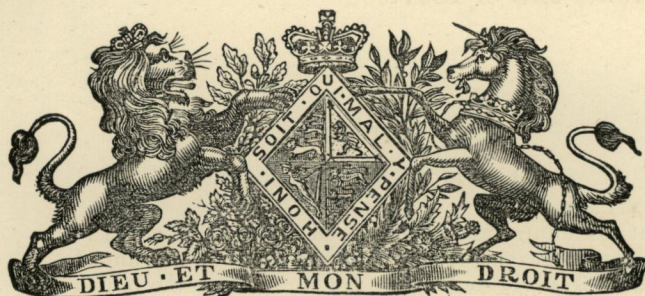

No. XLVI. (A.D. 1897.)

An Act to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales a certain Sum to make good supplies granted for the Services of the Year 1897-8. [Assented to, 10th December, 1897.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects Preamble. the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have granted to Your Majesty the sum of Thirty-two thousand and five hundred pounds, for the Services set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed: And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Her Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales £32,500 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund. there shall be further appropriated and is hereby appropriated and shall be issued and applied for or towards the uses and purposes hereafter expressed, the sum of Thirty-two thousand and five hundred pounds for the Services specified in the Schedule hereto annexed.

2.

Consolidated Revenue Fund (Municipal Grant).

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

2. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Short title.

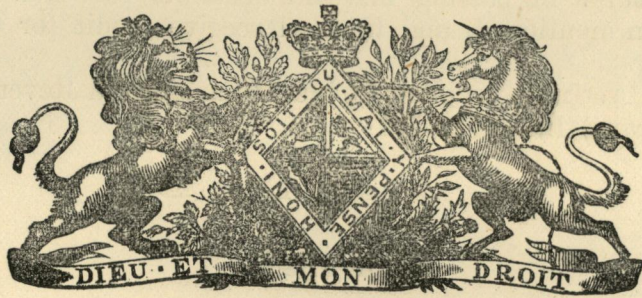

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall be further appropriated and is hereby appropriated and shall be issued and applied for or towards the uses and purposes hereafter expressed, the sum of Thirty-two thousand and five hundred pounds for the Services specified in the Schedule hereto annexed. £32,500 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

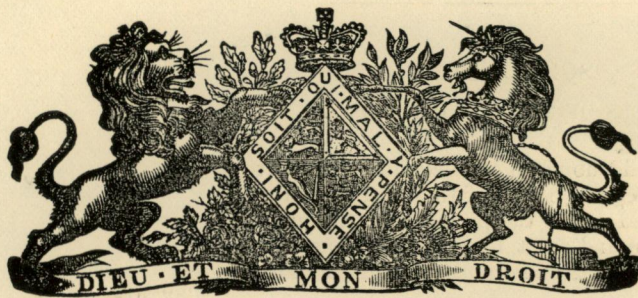
