The sum of One million five hundred and twenty-five thousand and fifty-eight pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the Colony during the months of July, August, and September, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven. And

The sum of Five hundred and seventy-nine thousand pounds for the Services set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Her Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order. 2. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
