B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—


1. From and after the first day of January, one thousand eight Grant of Income Tax. hundred and ninety-six, there shall be annually levied and paid, under the provisions of the Land and Income Tax Assessment Act of 1895, and in the manner therein prescribed, an Income Tax of sixpence in the pound on the amount of all incomes chargeable thereunder.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Income Tax Act of 1895."


2. This Act may be cited as the "Income Tax Act of 1895."




