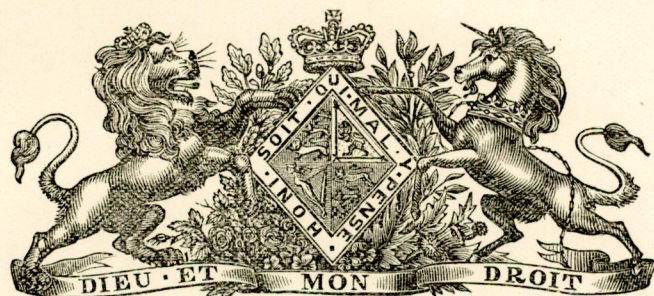

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. From and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, there shall be annually levied and paid, under the provisions of the Land and Income Tax Assessment Act of 1895, and in the manner therein prescribed, an Income Tax of sixpence in the pound on the amount of all incomes chargeable thereunder. Grant of Income Tax.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Income Tax Act of 1895." Short title.

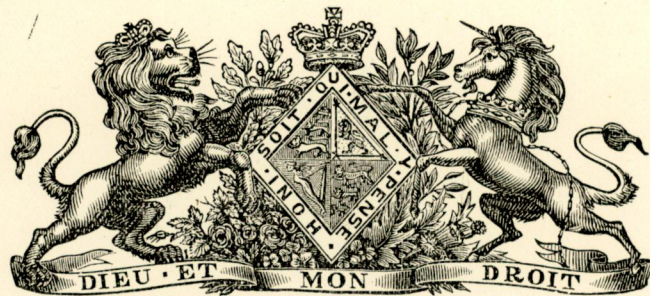

# VICTORIAN REGIMENT

REGIMENTAL REGULATIONS

## ARTICLE

Art. 1. The Regiment shall be known by the name of the  
Victorian Regiment.

Art. 2. The Regiment shall consist of the following Companies, to-wit:  
The Grenadier Company, The Rifle Company, The Fusilier Company,  
The Light Infantry Company, The Mousers Company, The  
The Band, and the Hospital Company. The Regiment shall be  
under the command of the Colonel, who shall be appointed by  
His Majesty's Commission. The Regiment shall be subject to  
the orders of the Adjutant-General, and shall be regulated  
according to the provisions of the several Acts of Parliament  
in that behalf made, and to the orders of the Secretary of  
War, and to the orders of the Commander-in-Chief of the  
Army.

Art. 3. The Regiment shall be subject to the same laws and  
regulations as the other Regiments of the Army.

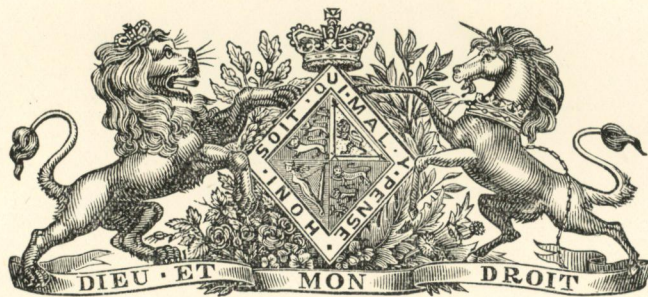

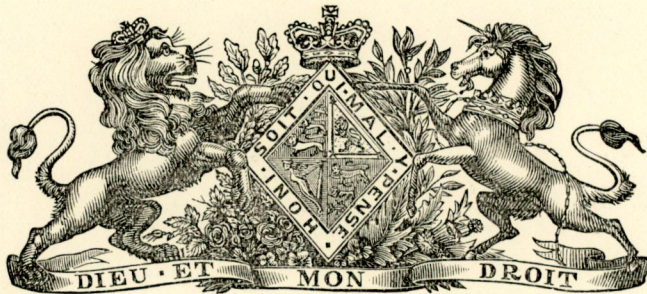
