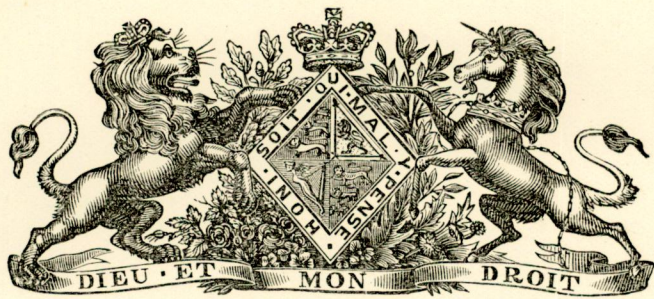

An Act to impose a Tax in respect of Land. [Assented to, 12th December, 1895.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. From and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, there shall be annually assessed, levied, and paid under the provisions of, and subject to the exemptions and deductions enacted in the Land and Income Tax Assessment Act of 1895, and in the manner therein prescribed, a land tax of one penny in the pound of the unimproved value of all lands as in the said Act specified. Grant of Land Tax.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Land Tax Act of 1895." Short title.

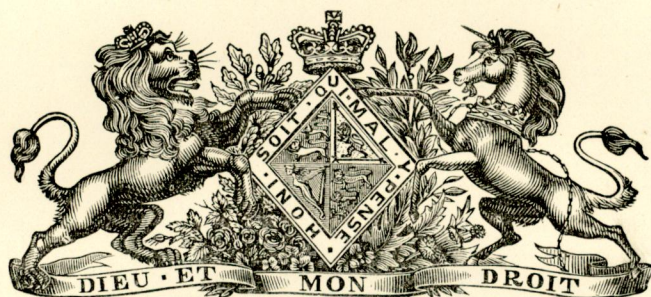

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. From and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, there shall be annually assessed, levied, and paid under the provisions of, and subject to the exemptions and deductions enacted in the Land and Income Tax Assessment Act of 1895, and in the manner therein prescribed, a land tax of one penny in the pound of the unimproved value of all lands as in the said Act specified. Grant of Land Tax.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Land Tax Act of 1895." Short title.

I have examined this Bill, and find it to correspond in all respects with the Bill as finally passed by both Houses.

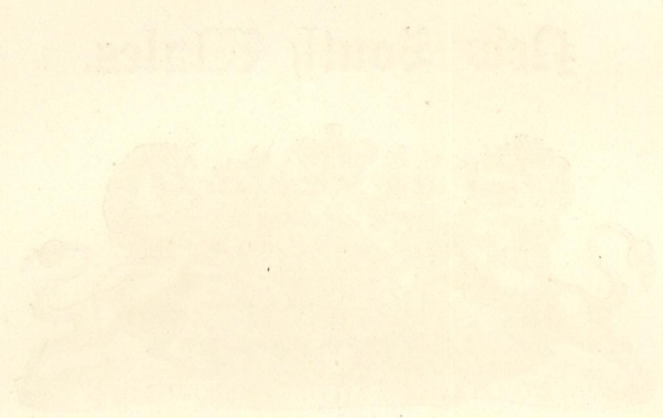

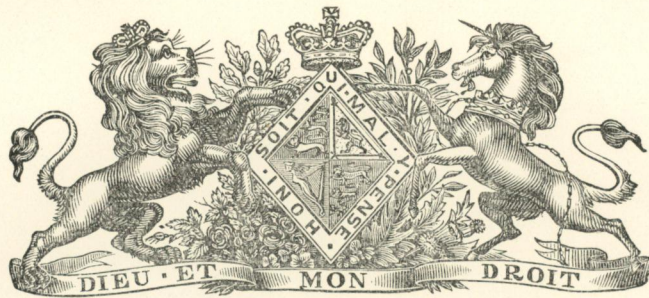

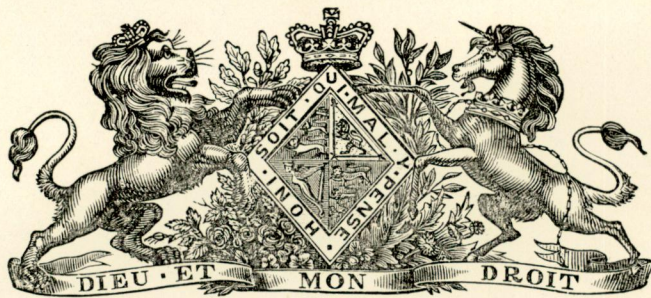
