## No. XXXII.

An Act to authorise the raising of a Loan for the Public Service of the Colony, and for other purposes. [Assented to, 16th November, 1896.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with Governor may raise the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legisla-money by sale of debentures or issue tive Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by of stock. the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor to raise by the sale of Debentures or the issue of Stock, secured upon the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony, and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding four per centum per annum, such sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Two million two hundred and seventy-one

seventy-one thousand three hundred and seventy-six pounds, as are respectively set against the following Public Works and Services, that is to say:—

2. Any Stock issued within the Colony under this Act shall, Creation of Stock and as to a sum not exceeding Two million and sixty-three thousand two stablishment of hundred and fifty-three pounds, be styled "New South Wales Funded" Stock," and shall run pari passu and be redeemable concurrently with the Stock issued under the provisions of the "Funded Stock Act of 1892," and shall, if sold otherwise than by tender, be purchasable at the Treasury upon any lawful day; and, as to a sum not exceeding two hundred and eight thousand one hundred and twentythree pounds, shall be styled "New South Wales 1927 Stock, and shall be redeemable on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, by means of a Sinking Fund, for the purpose of which a sum not exceeding six thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven pounds eight shillings and eight pence shall be set apart out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, annually, upon the thirtieth day of June in each year, commencing with the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight, until the date of redemption; and such Stock shall, if sold otherwise than by tender, be purchasable in like manner as the Stock hereinbefore mentioned.

7. (I) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any special Moneys borrowed Act, the provisions of the Loans Fund Amalgamation Act of 1879 under special Acts to Loans shall be deemed to have applied and to apply to and in respect of all Fund Amalgamation moneys borrowed or which may hereafter be borrowed under the Act. authority of any special Act; and the provisions of any special Act so far as they repeal, amend, or restrict the operation of any of the provisions of the Loans Fund Amalgamation Act of 1879 are hereby declared to have been and to be of no effect, and any moneys at credit of the General Loan Account may be applied to any service authorised by a special Act notwithstanding that no money has been raised under such special Act.

(IV) Any sums carried to the General Loan Account under the authority of this section or paid into the Treasury by way of refund of advances from the said account, either before or after the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to have been and to be money included in that account; and the provisions of the Loans Fund Amalgamation Act of 1879 shall be deemed to have applied and to apply to the said sums as though those sums had been borrowed under the authority of a special Act.

Definitions.

8. In this Act the expressions "special Act" and "loan services" have the meanings given to them respectively in the Loans Fund Amalgamation Act of 1879, "Governor" means Governor with the advice of the Executive Council, "Treasurer" means the Colonial Treasurer for the time being, and the expression "Stock" means Inscribed or Funded Stock.

Short title.

9. This Act may be cited as the "Loan Act of 1896."

2. Any Stock issued within the Colony under this Act shall, Creation of Stock and as to a sum not exceeding Two million and sixty-three thousand two stablishment of hundred and fifty-three pounds, be styled "New South Wales Funded" Sinking Fund. Stock," and shall run pari passu and be redeemable concurrently with the Stock issued under the provisions of the "Funded Stock Act of 1892," and shall, if sold otherwise than by tender, be purchasable at the Treasury upon any lawful day; and, as to a sum not exceeding two hundred and eight thousand one hundred and twentythree pounds, shall be styled "New South Wales 1927 Stock," and shall be redeemable on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, by means of a Sinking Fund, for the purpose of which a sum not exceeding six thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven pounds eight shillings and eight pence shall be set apart out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, annually, upon the thirtieth day of June in each year, commencing with the thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight, until the date of redemption; and such Stock shall, if sold otherwise than by tender, be purchasable in like manner as the Stock hereinbefore mentioned.

3. The Governor may make regulations for dealing with the Regulations for Sinking Fund established by the last preceding section, and may fund may be made appoint Commissioners.

Debentures or Stock sold or issued under this Act are Power to trustees hereby declared to be for all purposes Government Securities; and and others to invest in Debentures or all corporations and other persons whatsoever shall have power to Stock. invest in the purchase of such Debentures and Stock any property held by them, whether as trustees or otherwise, which they are not expressly forbidden to invest in Government Stock or Securities, without on that account being liable as for a breach of trust or incurring any liability whatsoever, provided that such investment is in other respects reasonable and proper.

7. (I) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any special Moneys borrowed Act, the provisions of the Loans Fund Amalgamation Act of 1879 under special Acts to shall be deemed to have applied and the special Acts to the special Acts to have applied and the special Acts to have a special Acts to shall be deemed to have applied and to apply to and in respect of all Fund Amalgamation moneys borrowed or which may hereafter be borrowed under the Act. authority of any special Act; and the provisions of any special Act so far as they repeal, amend, or restrict the operation of any of the provisions of the Loans Fund Amalgamation Act of 1879 are hereby declared to have been and to be of no effect, and any moneys at credit of the General Loan Account may be applied to any service authorised by a special Act notwithstanding that no money has been raised under such special Act.

(II) It shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer, in anticipa-Money may be tion of the exercise of any power to borrow conferred by any special carried to General Act, and to meet urgent demands on account of loan services, to carry to the General Loan Account such sums as the Governor may order and direct.

Repayment of said money.

(III) It shall be lawful for the said Treasurer to cause to be transferred from the General Loan Account such sums as the Governor may order and direct by way of refund or discharge of any sums carried to the said account, either before or after the commencement of this Act.

Loans Fund Amalgamation Act to apply to money at credit of account.

(IV) Any sums carried to the General Loan Account under the authority of this section or paid into the Treasury by way of refund of advances from the said account, either before or after the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to have been and to be money included in that account; and the provisions of the Loans Fund Amalgamation Act of 1879 shall be deemed to have applied and to apply to the said sums as though those sums had been borrowed under the authority of a special Act.

Definitions.

8. In this Act the expressions "special Act" and "loan services" have the meanings given to them respectively in the Loans Fund Amalgamation Act of 1879, "Governor" means Governor with the advice of the Executive Council, "Treasurer" means the Colonial Treasurer for the time being, and the expression "Stock" means Inscribed or Funded Stock.

Short title.

9. This Act may be cited as the "Loan Act of 1896."
