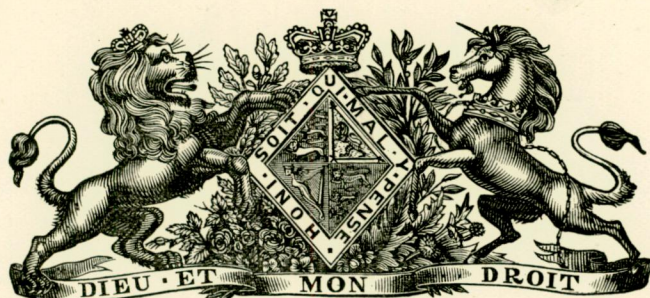

An Act to amend Section 3 of the Joint Stock Companies' Arrangement Act, 1891. [Assented to, 19th December, 1895.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. That section three of the Joint Stock Companies' Arrangement Act, 1891, shall be and the same is hereby continued for a further period of two years from the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, notwithstanding the proviso to the said section, or anything therein contained. Section 3 continued for period of two years.

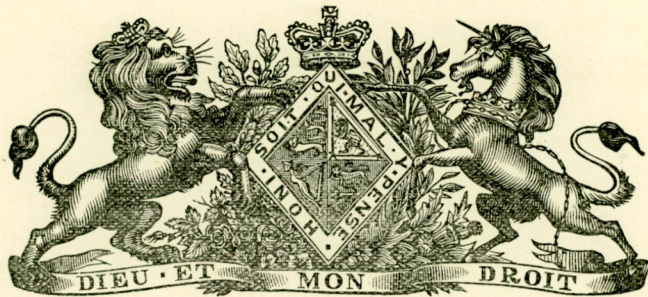
2. This Act may be cited as the "Joint Stock Companies' Arrangement Act Amendment Act, 1895." Short title.

1. That section three of the Joint Stock Companies' Arrangement Act, 1891, shall be and the same is hereby continued for a further period of two years from the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, notwithstanding the proviso to the said section, or anything therein contained. Section 3 continued for period of two years.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Joint Stock Companies' Arrangement Act Amendment Act, 1895." Short title.

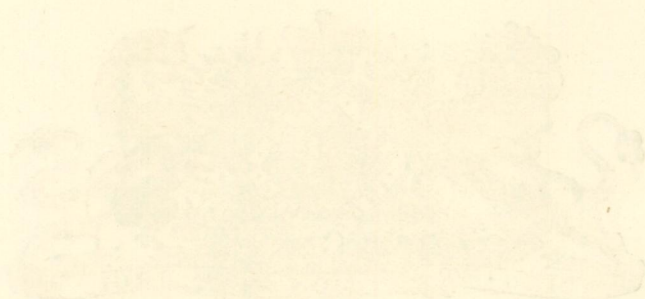

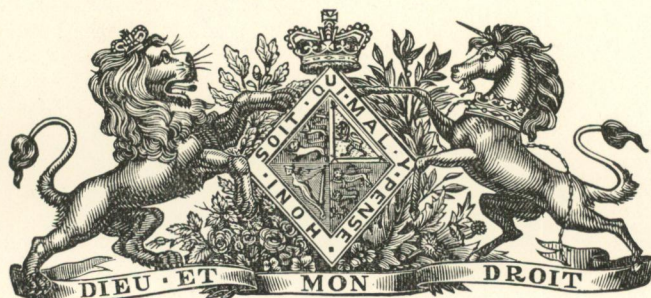

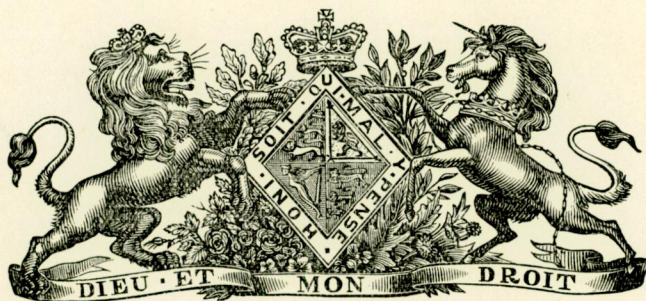
