An Act to fix certain Public Holidays on Mondays.

E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with But the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. 10 Monday shall be a Bank Holiday in lieu thereof unless otherwise proclaimed by notice in the Government Gazette; and the Schedule to the Bank Holidays Act, 1875, is hereby amended accordingly.
