Act No. 36, 1898.

An Act to authorise the raising of a Loan for the Public Service of the Colony, and for other purposes. [Assented to, 23rd December, 1898.

DE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with Be it enacted by the Queen's Lieuwilled and Legislathe advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor to raise by the sale of Governor may raise Debentures or the issue of Stock, secured upon the Consolidated money by sale of debentures or issue Revenue Fund of the Colony, and bearing interest at a rate not of stock. exceeding four per centum per annum, such sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Two million two hundred and thirty-three
