

1. The powers granted to and the duties imposed on the Board Provisions of of Water Supply and Sewerage by the Metropolitan-Water and Sewerage with regard to water Acts, 1880–1889, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act supply to apply to Camden Extension Act of 1894, in respect of the construction of works for municipality. water supply and the supply of water and the carrying out of the provisions of those Acts in relation thereto within the city and suburbs of Sydney, may be exercised and shall be performed by the said board within the boundaries of the municipal district of Camden.

2. This Act shall be construed with the Metropolitan Water and Incorporation and Sewerage Acts, 1880-1889, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage short title. Act Extension Act of 1894, and may be cited as the "Metropolitan Water (Camden) Act, 1898."

I have examined this Bill, and find it to correspond in all respects with the Bill as finally passed by both Houses.


