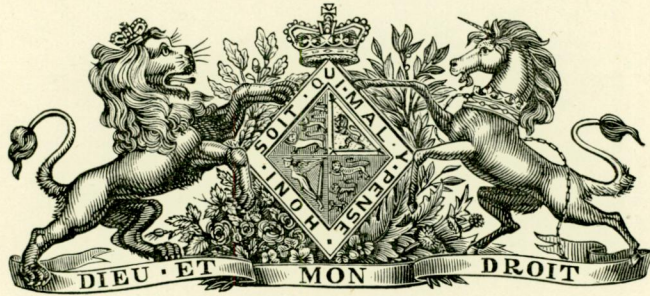

Act No. 33, 1898.

An Act to extend the provisions of the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Acts, 1880-1889, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act Extension Act of 1894 with regard to water supply to the Municipal District of Camden. [Assented to, 17th December, 1898.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The powers granted to and the duties imposed on the Board of Water Supply and Sewerage by the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Acts, 1880-1889, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act Extension Act of 1894, in respect of the construction of works for water supply and the supply of water and the carrying out of the provisions of those Acts in relation thereto within the city and suburbs of Sydney, may be exercised and shall be performed by the said board within the boundaries of the municipal district of Camden.

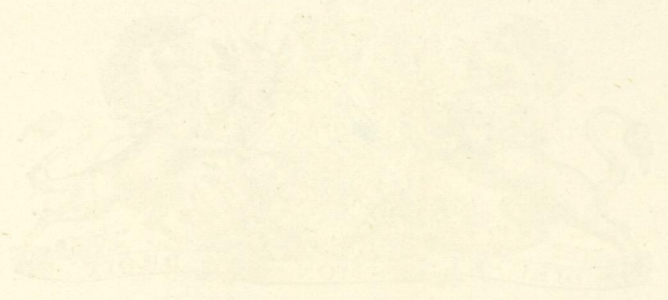

In Act to extend the provisions of the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act, 1852, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act Extension Act of 1881 with regard to water supply to the Municipal District of Chelsea. [Assented to the 10th day of July 1893.]

It is enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, in that behalf lawfully assembled, that the following provisions shall have effect as if they were contained in an Act of Parliament.

1. The powers conferred on and the duties imposed on the Board of Water Supply and Sewerage by the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act, 1852, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act Extension Act of 1881, in respect of the construction of works for the supply of water and the carrying out of the provisions of those Acts in relation thereto within the city and suburbs of Chelsea, may be exercised and shall be performed by the said Board within the boundaries of the municipal district of Chelsea.

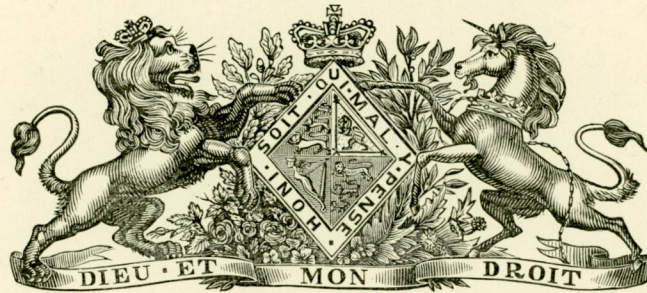
2. This Act shall be construed with the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act, 1852, and the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Act Extension Act of 1881, and may be cited as the Metropolitan Water (Chelsea) Act, 1893.

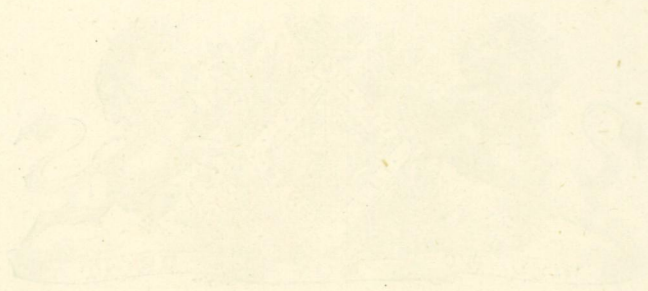

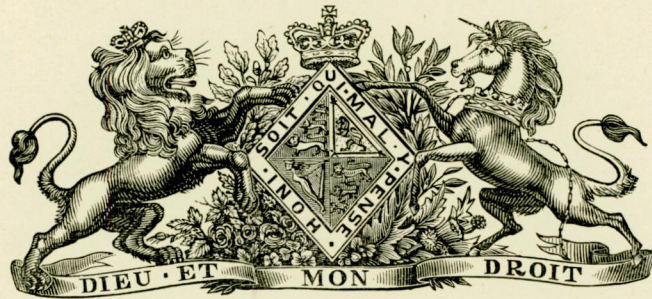
