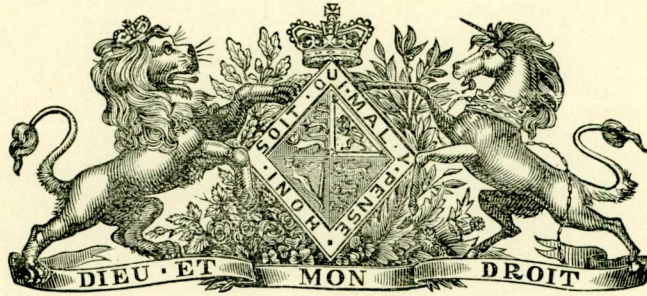

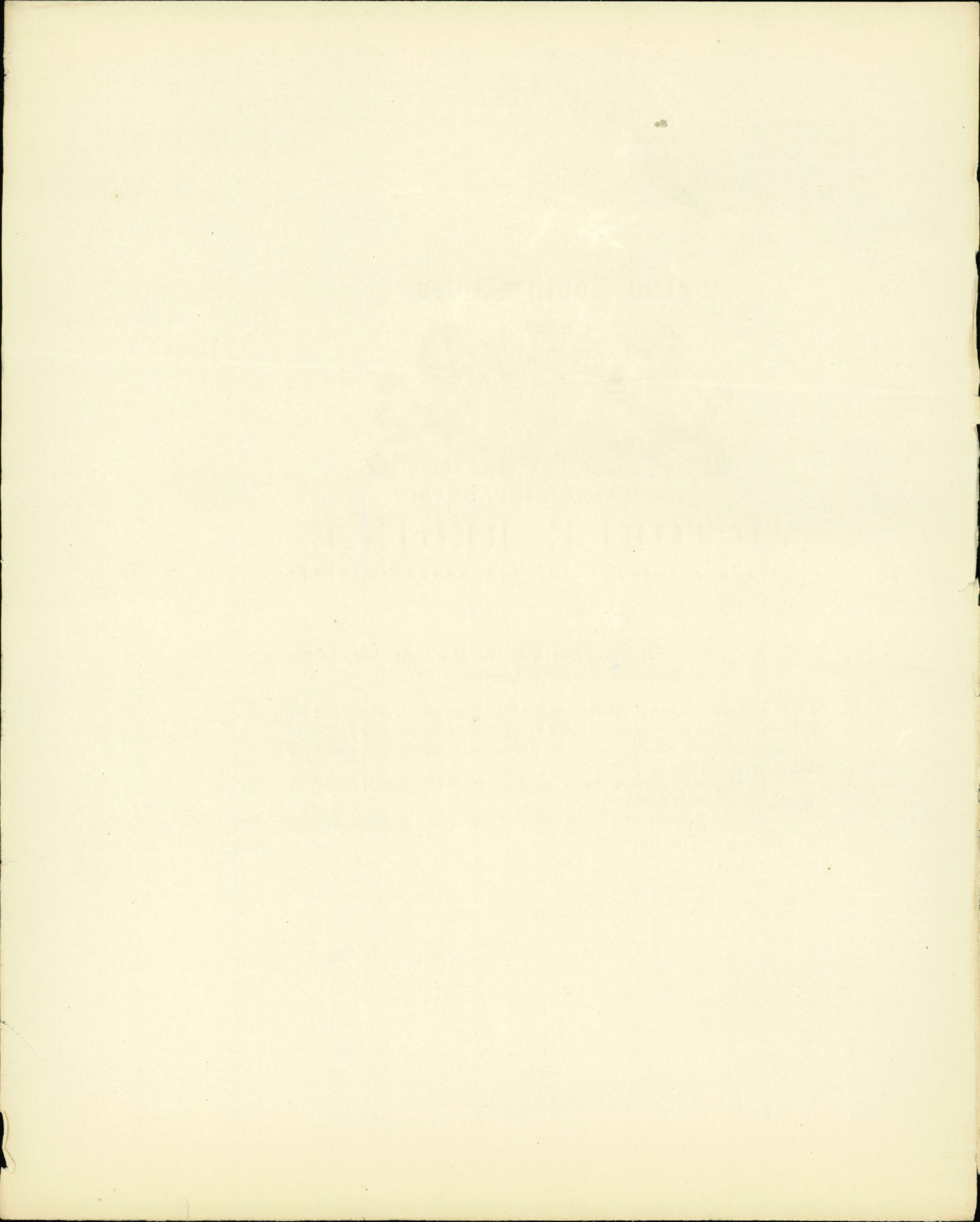
An Act to amend the Port Kembla Harbour Act, 1898.

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

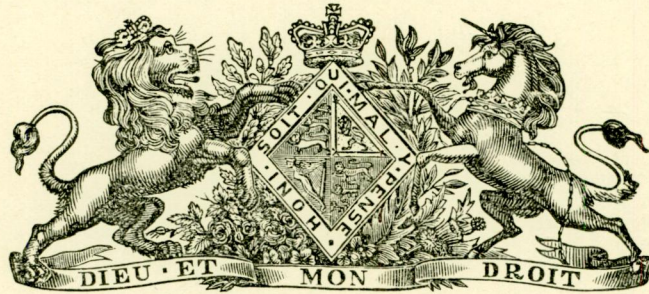

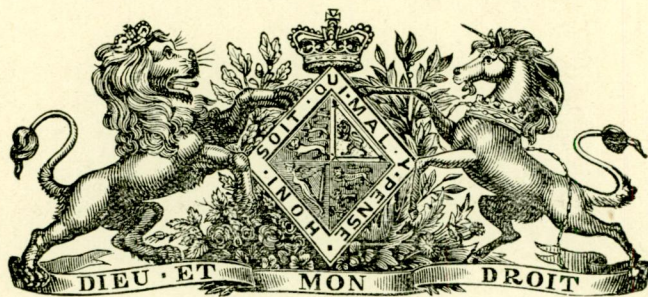

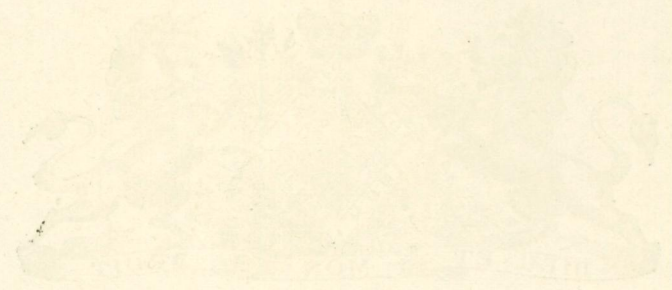

BY APPOINTMENT TO HER MAJESTY

## VICTORIA REGINA

Act No. 1800

As first amended the 14th March 1894

BE it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of the Colony of New Zealand,  
that the following provisions shall have effect as if they had been  
enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty in Council:

1. The name of the Colony of New Zealand shall be the Colony of New Zealand.  
2. The name of the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand shall be the Governor.  
3. The name of the Executive Council of the Colony of New Zealand shall be the Executive Council.  
4. The name of the Legislative Council of the Colony of New Zealand shall be the Legislative Council.
