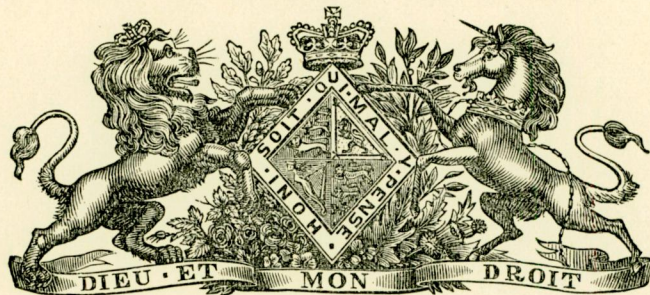

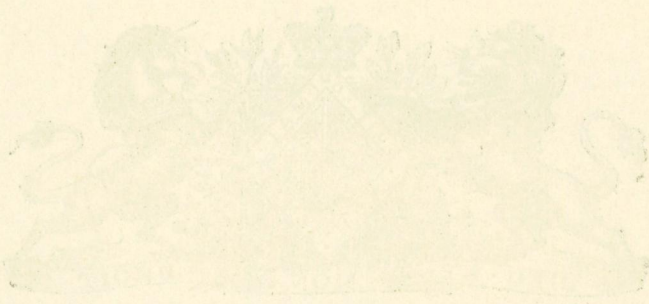
An Act to amend the Public Hospitals Act, 1898. [Assented to,
18th September, 1900.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The words "ten shillings" are hereby substituted for the Amendment of s. 5 of Act No. 16, 1898. words "one pound" wherever occurring in section five of the Public Hospitals Act, 1898.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Public Hospitals (Voting) Short title. Act, 1900."

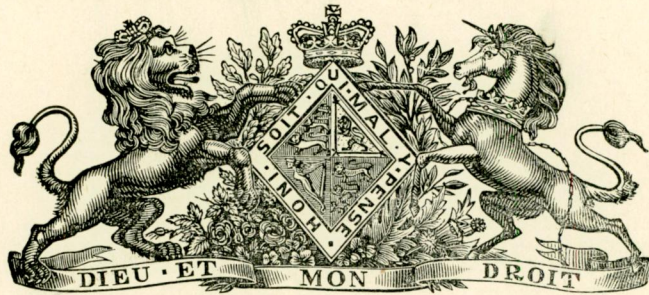

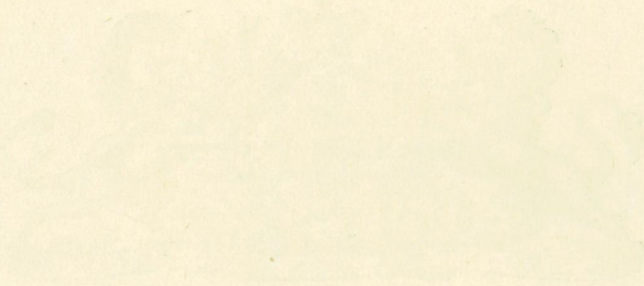

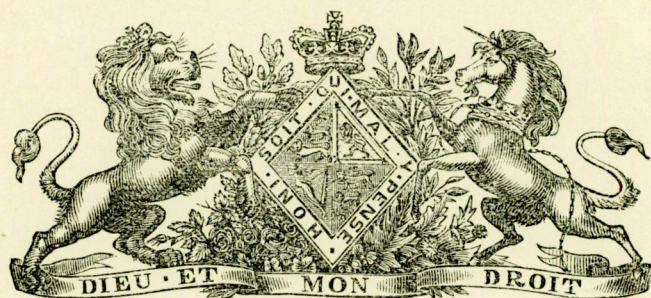
