- 15 law they would be liable but for the passing of this Act as being concerned in illegal lotteries, little-goes, or unlawful games by reason of anything done by them or any of them in furtherance of the allotment or distribution by scheme or otherwise of articles of use or ornament; and the proviso to section one of the said Act shall be incorporated 20 with and read as a proviso to this section.
