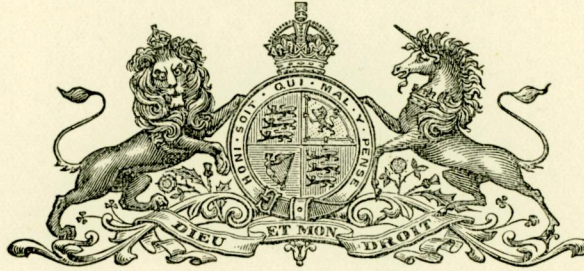

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Advances to Settlers (Amendment) Act, 1902," and shall be read with the Advances to Settlers Act, 1899, and the Advances to Settlers (Amendment) Act, 1901. Short title.

2. Section one of the Advances to Settlers Act, 1899, is amended by substituting the word "ten" for the word "five" in that section. Amendment of section 1 of Advances to Settlers Act, 1899.

3. Section four of the Advances to Settlers Act, 1899, is amended by the omission of the words "at a rate not exceeding three and a half pounds per annum for every one hundred pounds" and substituting therefor the words "in respect." Amendment of section 4 of Advances to Settlers Act, 1899.

4. An advance may be made under section nine of the Advances to Settlers Act, 1899, to an amount not exceeding one thousand five hundred pounds; and subsection (d) of that section is hereby amended accordingly. Amount of advance.

5. The rate of interest payable in respect of any advance made after the passing of this Act shall be not less than four per centum per annum, and subsection (e) of section nine of the Advances to Settlers Act, 1899, is hereby amended accordingly. Rate of interest.

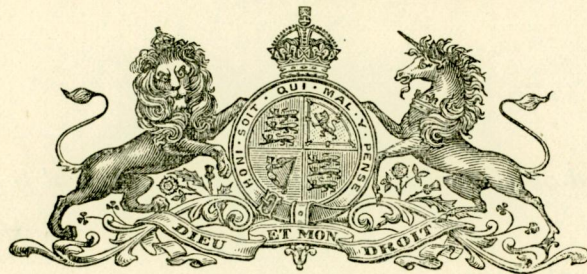
