Act No. , 1901.

An Act to amend the Coal Mines Regulation Act of 1896.

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. This Act may be cited as the "Coal Mines Regulation Short title. (Further Amendment) Act, 1901," and shall be construed with the Coal Mines Regulation Act, 1896, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act.

2. No person shall act at the same time as manager of two or Mines owned by different persons shall be under

If any person acts as manager in contravention of this section, shall be under such person and any owner of a mine who employs him as manager, knowing that he is so acting in contravention of this section, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds.

3. After the commencement of this Act, no certificates of No further certificate service shall be granted under section eight of the Principal Act. of service under section 8.
