DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Governor's Salary Act, 1901." short title.

2. (1) The annual amount payable for the salary of any Amount of Governor of New South Wales hereafter to be appointed shall be five Governor's salary and salaries of his staff.

(2) The following annual amounts shall be payable in respect

of the members of the staff of any such Governor, namely—

Governor's private secretary—Three hundred and fifty pounds. Governor's aide-de-camp—Three hundred and fifty pounds.

(3) Such annual amounts are hereby permanently appro-

priated for the above services.

(4) For the purpose of the above provisions Schedule A to the Constitution Act is amended by substituting the figures 5,000 for the figures 7,000, and the figures 350 for the figures 400 in that Schedule.
