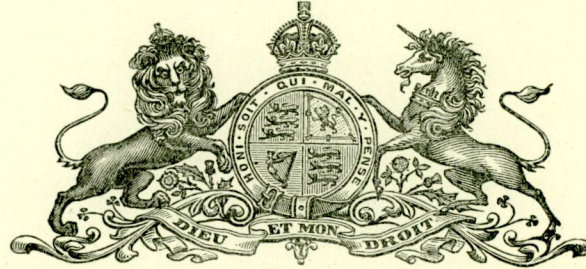

### Act No. 112, 1902.

An Act to grant monetary assistance to municipalities in making, maintaining, curbing and guttering of streets, and asphaltting footpaths. [Assented to, 24th December, 1902.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Municipalities Relief Act, 1902."

Short title.

2. For the purpose of making, maintaining, curbing, and guttering streets and asphaltting footpaths within municipalities there may be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in respect of the municipal year commencing in February, one thousand nine hundred and three, to the council of each municipality a sum equal to two shillings and six pence in each pound sterling actually raised in the municipality by rates, assessments, and subscriptions during the last preceding municipal year.

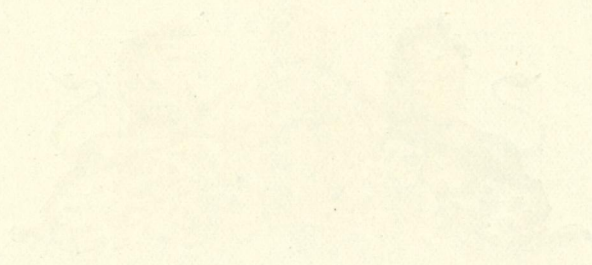
Endowment of municipalities for 1903.

It enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Municipalities Relief Act, 1902."
2. For the purpose of curbing, maintaining, curbing and gutting streets and repaving footpaths within municipalities there may be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in respect of the municipal year commencing in February, one thousand nine hundred and three to the council of each municipality a sum equal to two shillings and six pence in each pound sterling legally raised in the municipality by rates, assessments, and subscriptions during the last preceding municipal year.
- Such payment shall be made half-yearly upon receipt of the account prepared in subsection one of section one hundred and fifty-seven of the Municipalities Act, 1901.
- Provided that in each payment shall be made in respect of a municipality which during such municipal year is in receipt of endorsement under section one hundred and fifty-seven aforesaid.

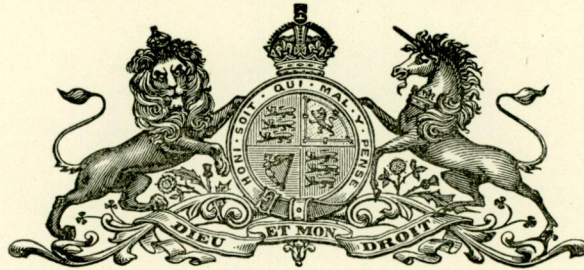
