
B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. That clause ten subsection one, of the Truck Act of 1900, Subscriptions to be amended by adding the words "or where within the county of hospitals.' 
