A BILL

To consolidate the enactments relating to the imposition of
a Tax on Incomes.

[MR. WISE ;—21 August, 1901.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the
authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of Commencement and
January, one thousand nine hundred and two, and may be cited as the short title.
“Income Tax Act, 1901.”

2. The Income Tax Act of 1895 is hereby repealed. Repeal.

3. From and after the commencement of this Act there shall Grant of Income
be annually levied and paid under the provisions of the Land and Tax.
Income Tax Assessment Act, 1901, and in the manner therein 59 Vic. No. 17, s. 1.
prescribed an Income Tax of sixpence in the pound on the amount of
all incomes chargeable thereunder.

Enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of
January, one thousand nine hundred and two, and may be cited as the
"Income Tax Act, 1901."

2. The Income Tax Act of 1895 is hereby repealed.
3. From and after the commencement of this Act there shall
be annually levied and paid under the provisions of the Land and
Income Tax Assessment Act, 1901, and in the manner therein
prescribed an Income Tax of expense in the amount of the amount of
