## A BILL

To consolidate the enactments relating to the imposition of a  
Tax in respect of Land.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative  
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the  
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of Commencement and  
short title.  
January one thousand nine hundred and two, and may be cited as the  
“ Land Tax Act, 1901.”

2. The Land Tax Act of 1895 is hereby repealed. Repeal.

3. From and after the commencement of this Act, there shall Grant of Land Tax.

be annually assessed, levied, and paid, under the provisions of and  
subject to the exemptions and deductions enacted in the Land and  
Income Tax Assessment Act, 1901, and in the manner therein

Enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative  
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the  
authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of  
January one thousand nine hundred and two, and may be cited as the  
"Land Tax Act, 1901."

2. The Land Tax Act of 1892 is hereby repealed.

3. From and after the commencement of this Act, there shall  
be annually assessed, levied, and paid, under the provisions of and  
subject to the exemptions and deductions enacted in the said Act  
in respect of Land Tax Assessment Act, 1901, and in the manner therein  
prescribed, a Land Tax of one penny in the pound of the unimproved  
value of all lands as in the said Act specified.
