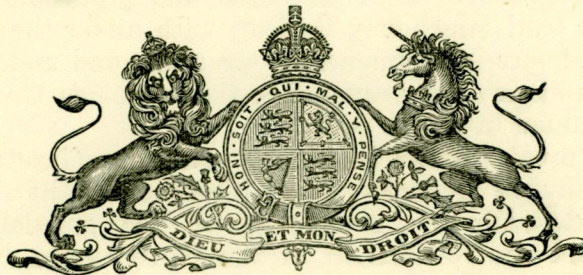

Act No. 9, 1905.

An Act to vest the lands of the Wollongong Harbour Trust in His Majesty ; to provide that such lands may be dealt with as Crown lands ; to repeal the Wollongong Harbour Trust Act, 1889 ; and for other purposes. [Assented to, 21st August, 1905.]

WHEREAS by the Wollongong Harbour Trust Act, 1889, certain ^{Preamble.} Crown lands were, for the purposes of the Act, vested in certain commissioners constituted thereunder, and power was given to the said commissioners to purchase and resume lands : And whereas, by proclamation of the Governor, dated the second day of December, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, made in pursuance of the said Act, the said trust was dissolved, and the control of the whole of the lands of the trust, subject to all liabilities and obligations attached to the same, with all powers created or otherwise vested in such trust by

by the said Act, was vested in the Governor: And whereas it is desirable that the lands of the trust should be vested in His Majesty and be dealt with as Crown lands: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Wollongong Harbour Trust Resumption Act, 1905."

Repeal.

2. The Wollongong Harbour Trust Act, 1889, is hereby repealed.

Lands of the Wollongong Harbour Trust vested in His Majesty, and may be dealt with as Crown lands.

3. The said lands are hereby vested in His Majesty for an estate in fee-simple, free from all trusts and provisions affecting the same; and the said lands may be dealt with under the Crown Lands Act of 1884 and any Acts amending the same, and under the Mining Act of 1874 and any Acts amending the same, as Crown lands (as respectively defined in those Acts).

Proclamation of population area of Wollongong and notification of town boundaries of town of Wollongong to apply to lands of Wollongong Harbour Trust.

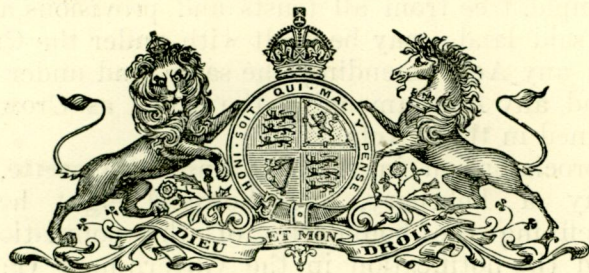

The proclamation in the Government Gazette, dated the twenty-sixth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, defining the boundaries of the population area of Wollongong, and the notification in the Government Gazette, dated the twentieth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, defining the town boundaries of the town of Wollongong, shall be held to apply and to have applied to the said lands as if the Wollongong Harbour Trust Act, 1889, had not been enacted.

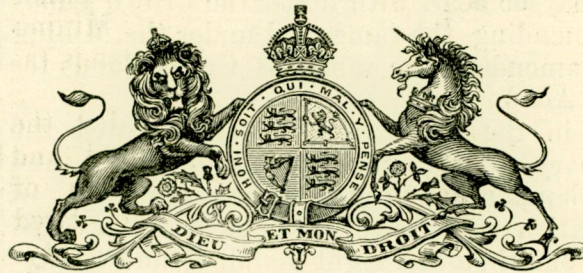

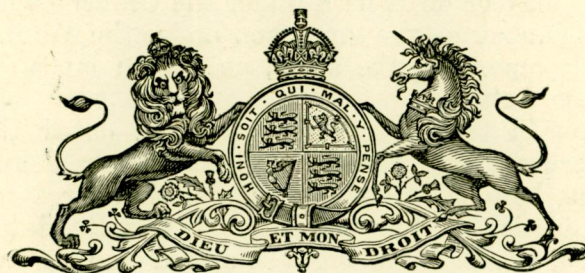
