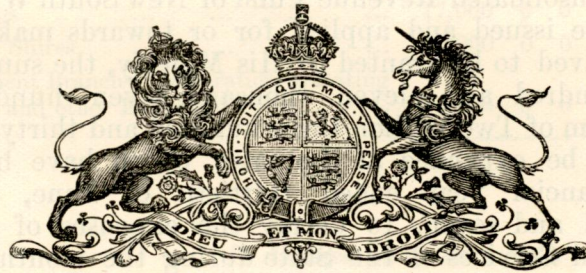

Act No. , 1907.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1907-1908, and out of the Public Works Fund; and for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, Preamble.
the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three million five hundred and fifty-five thousand 5 two hundred pounds, that is to say:—

10 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Two million three hundred and thirty-six thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, September, and October, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth June, one thousand nine hundred and

eight; and the sum of Eight hundred and seventy-five thousand seven hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said funds the sum so granted to His Majesty : Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of

15 Three million two hundred and eleven thousand seven hundred pounds, of which the sum of Two million three hundred and thirty-six thousand pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth of June, one thousand nine hundred and seven, to defray the expenses of the

20 various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, September, and October, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth of June, one thousand nine hundred and eight, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1907-1908, and the sum of Eight

25 hundred and seventy-five thousand seven hundred pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Three hundred and forty-three

30 thousand five hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

£343,500 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.

3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportion as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and

35 directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund respectively.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

4. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be

40 allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same

45 accordingly.

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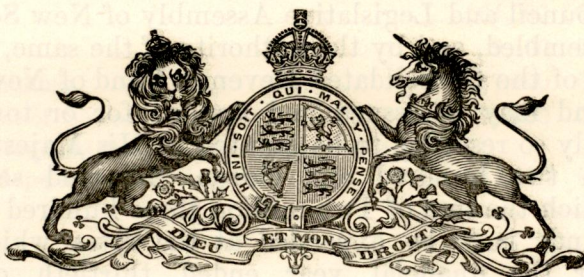

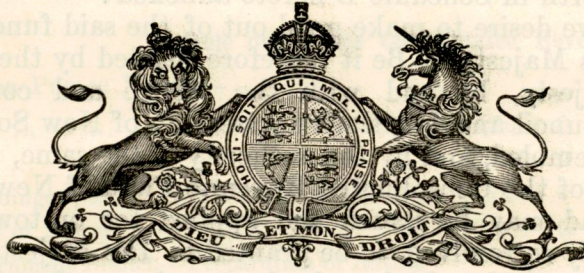

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Three million two hundred and eleven thousand seven hundred pounds, of which the sum of Two million three hundred and thirty-six thousand pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth of June, one thousand nine hundred and seven, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, September, and October, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth of June, one thousand nine hundred and eight, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1907-1908, and the sum of Eight hundred and seventy-five thousand seven hundred pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

£343,500 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Three hundred and forty-three thousand five hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportion as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund respectively.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

4. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
