B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Oxford-street Extension short title.

2. The Metropolitan Board of Water Supply and Sewerage is Land vested in hereby divested of the lands described in the Schedule hereto, and the borough of Paddington for a said lands are vested in the borough of Paddington, subject to the public way. following conditions:—

(a) The council of the said borough shall, within six months after the commencement of this Act, construct and open for traffic a public way on the said land; (b)

(b) For the purpose of maintaining, altering, repairing, and constructing any works of the Crown or of the Metropolitan Board of Water Supply and Sewerage on or under the said lands, the Crown and the Constructing Authority for such works and the said board shall, until the public way is opened on such lands, have the same powers, and in the exercise of such powers shall be subject to the same liabilities as if the said lands were streets.
