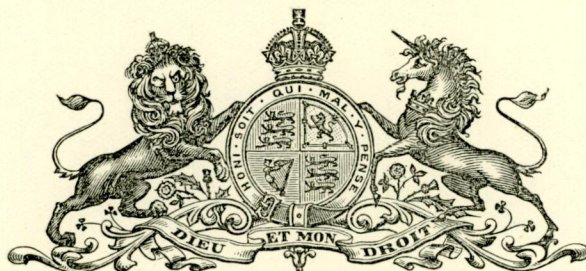

Act No. , 1906.

An Act to amend the Public Works Committee Act, 1904 ; to indemnify the Colonial Treasurer, the officers of the Treasury, and other persons in respect of certain payments ; and for other purposes.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

5 1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Works Committee Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1906."

2. Section four of the Public Works Committee Act, 1904, is hereby repealed. Repeal of section 4 of Public Works Committee Act, 1904.

10 3. The Colonial Treasurer, the officers of the Treasury, and all persons concerned or engaged in making any payments during the financial years 1905–1906 and 1906–1907 in excess of the respective amounts authorised by section four of the Public Works Committee Act, 1904, are hereby indemnified and held harmless for and in respect of any such payments made or to be made. Indemnity to Treasurer and his officers.

EDWARD VII. RIGHTS.

Act No. 1904.

An Act to amend the *Public Works Committee Act, 1904*; to indemnify the Colonial Treasurer, the officers of the Treasury, and other persons in respect of certain payments; and for other purposes.

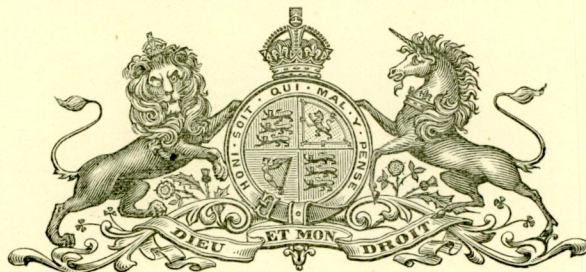
Enacted by the Queen, Her Majesty, and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Committee Act, 1904*.

2. Section four of the *Public Works Committee Act, 1904*, is amended so that it shall read as follows:—

3. The Colonial Treasurer, the officers of the Treasury, and all persons concerned or engaged in making any payments during the financial years 1903-1904 and 1904-1905 in pursuance of the respective amounts authorised by section four of the *Public Works Committee Act, 1904*, are hereby indemnified and their liabilities for and in respect of any such payments are hereby released.

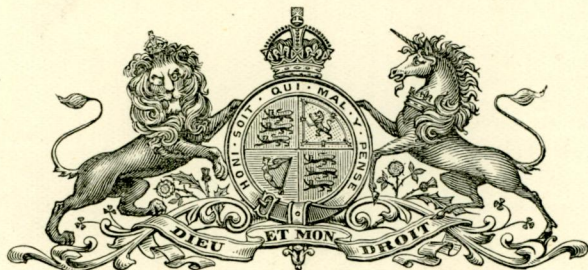
