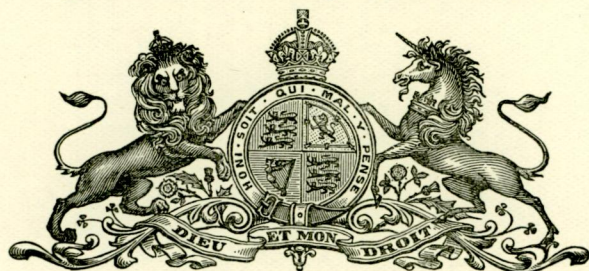

An Act to amend the Taxation Amending Act, 1905, in order to apply its provisions to municipalities; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

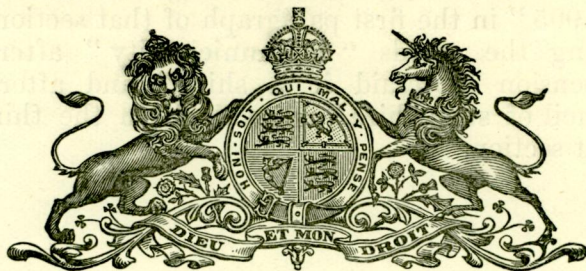

Act No. 47, 1906.

An Act to amend the Taxation Amending Act, 1905, in order to apply its provisions to municipalities; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 19th December, 1906.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Taxation Amending Act, Short title, 1906."

2. Section two of the Taxation Amending Act, 1905, is Amendment of section 2. amended by—
