[Mr. BAKER:—In Committee, 1904.]

1. It is enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

2. This Act may be cited as the Legislative Dental Union Act, 1904, and shall commence and take effect on and from the first day of January next following the passing hereof.

3. The Legislative Dental Hospital and the Dental Hospital of Sydney shall, on the commencement of this Act, be united under a single name to be determined as provided in this Act.

4. The name of the said united hospital shall be the Legislative Dental Hospital of New South Wales, and shall be the name of the hospital for all purposes, and shall apply to the buildings of the hospital.

5. The location of the said united hospital shall be the same as the location of the said Legislative Dental Hospital, and the site of the said united hospital shall be the same as the site of the said Legislative Dental Hospital.

6. The property of the said Legislative Dental Hospital and the Dental Hospital of Sydney shall, on the commencement of this Act, be transferred to the said united hospital, and shall be held and managed by the said united hospital as if it were the property of the said united hospital.
