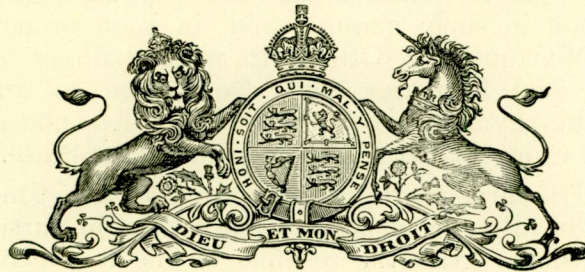

Act No. 19, 1905.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales towards the Services of the Year 1905-1906. [Assented to, 28th September, 1905.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects Preamble.
the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of One million one hundred and sixty-seven thousand eight hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth June, one thousand nine hundred and six: And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund

Consolidated Revenue Fund (No. 2).

Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

£1,167,800 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty for the said several Services, the sum of One million one hundred and sixty-seven thousand eight hundred pounds, to be expended at the rates which are shown on the Estimates for the financial year ending thirtieth June, one thousand nine hundred and six, as laid on the Table of the House, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1905-1906.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

2. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

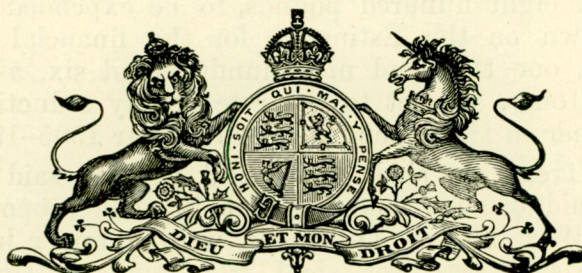

Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

In the name and on the behalf of His Majesty I assent to this Act.

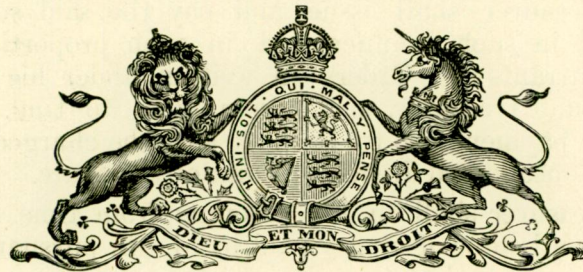

The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the 15 Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State. 20

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as 25 shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
