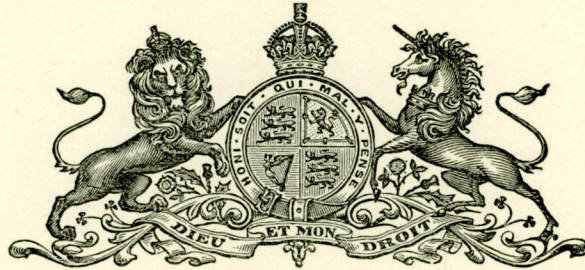

An Act to amend section forty-seven of the Coal Mines Regulation Act, 1902. [Assented to, 4th November, 1904.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Coal Mines Regulation Short title. (Inspection) Act, 1904," and shall be construed with the Coal Mines Regulation Act, 1902.

2. General Rule 39 of section forty-seven of the Coal Mines Amendment of section 47 of Act of 1902. Regulation Act, 1902, is hereby amended by omitting the word "working" before the word "miners" when occurring in that rule.

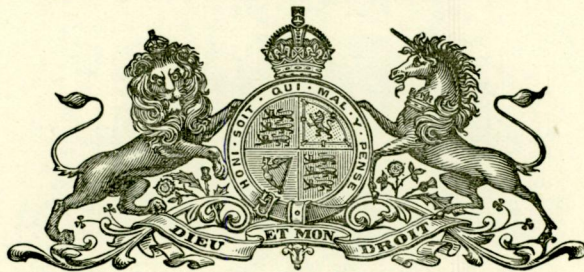

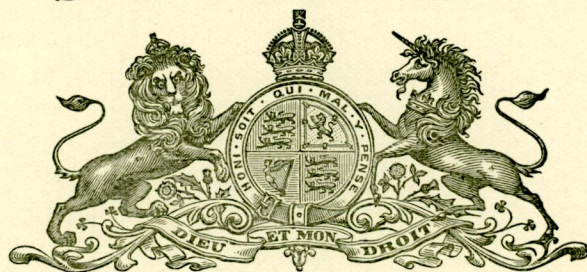
