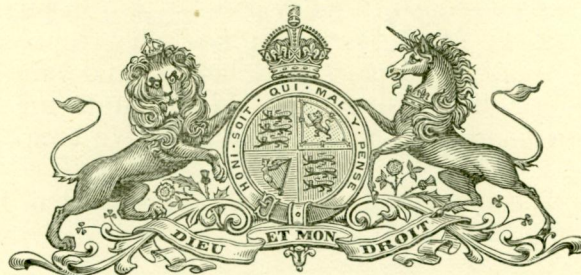

### Act No. 3, 1906.

An Act to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales a certain sum to make good supplies granted for the Services of the Year 1906-1907. [Assented to, 14th August, 1906.]

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects Preamble.  
the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Fifty thousand pounds, for the Services set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed: And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall be appropriated and is hereby appropriated and shall be issued £50,000 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

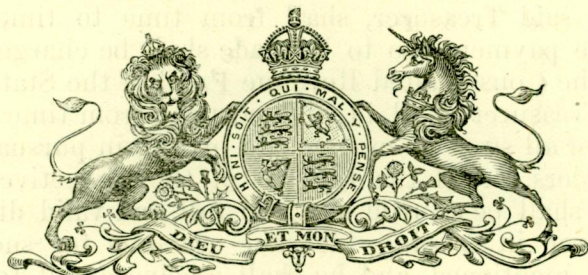

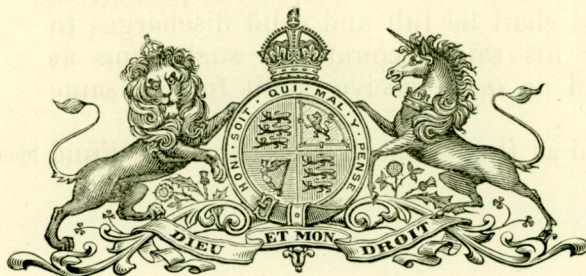
