WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, Preamble. the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three millions seven hundred and seventy-six thousand eight hundred and eighty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Two millions and fifteen thousand one hundred and thirty pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, and September, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and ten; and the sum of One million four hundred and seventy-six thousand five hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Two hundred and eighty-five thousand two hundred and fifty pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed:

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued out of the Public Works Fund. issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Two hundred and eighty-five thousand two hundred and fifty pounds for the Services specified in

Schedule B hereto annexed.

3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works

Fund respectively.
