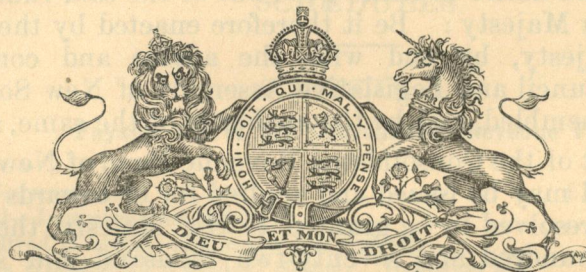

Act No. 3, 1910.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1910-1911, and out of the Public Works Fund; and for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 29th July, 1910.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, Preamble.
the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Five millions three hundred and fifteen thousand and sixty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million eight hundred and forty-two thousand nine hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, September, October, and November, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of
A June,

Consolidated Revenue Fund and Public Works Fund.

June, one thousand nine hundred and eleven; and the sum of Two millions one hundred and eighty-eight thousand one hundred and sixty pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed; and the sum of One million one hundred and forty-one thousand pounds for the services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of One hundred and forty-three thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule C hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said funds the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

£5,172,060 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Five millions one hundred and seventy-two thousand and sixty pounds, of which the sum of One million eight hundred and forty-two thousand nine hundred pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and ten, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, September, October, and November, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and eleven, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1910-1911, and the sum of Two millions one hundred and eighty-eight thousand one hundred and sixty pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed, and the sum of One million one hundred and forty-one thousand pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

£143,000 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of One hundred and forty-three thousand pounds for the Services specified in Schedule C hereto annexed.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund respectively.

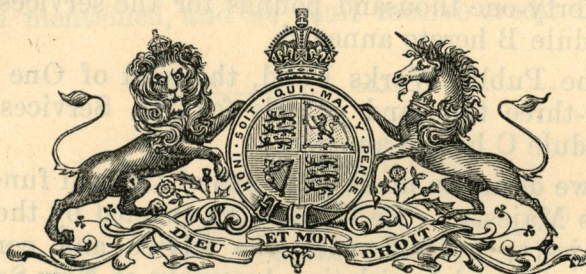

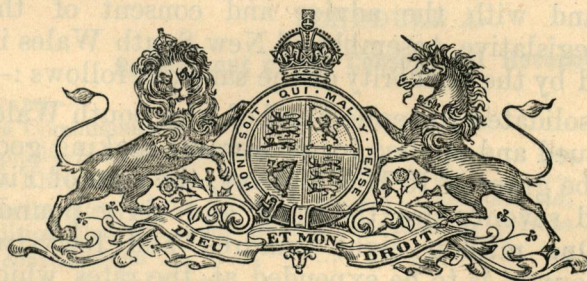

A BILL

To apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1910-1911, and out of the Public Works Fund; and for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan.

[MR. WADDELL;—28 July, 1910, A.M.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Five millions three hundred and fifteen thousand and sixty 5 pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million eight hundred and forty-two thousand nine hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, September, October, and November, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June,

Consolidated Revenue Fund and Public Works Fund.

June, one thousand nine hundred and eleven; and the sum of Two millions one hundred and eighty-eight thousand one hundred and sixty pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed; and the sum of One million one hundred and forty-one thousand pounds for the services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of One hundred and forty-three thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule C hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said funds the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

£5,172,060 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Five millions one hundred and seventy-two thousand and sixty pounds, of which the sum of One million eight hundred and forty-two thousand nine hundred pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and ten, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, September, October, and November, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and eleven, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1910–1911, and the sum of Two millions one hundred and eighty-eight thousand one hundred and sixty pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed, and the sum of One million one hundred and forty-one thousand pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

£143,000 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of One hundred and forty-three thousand pounds for the Services specified in Schedule C hereto annexed.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund respectively.

4. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.
