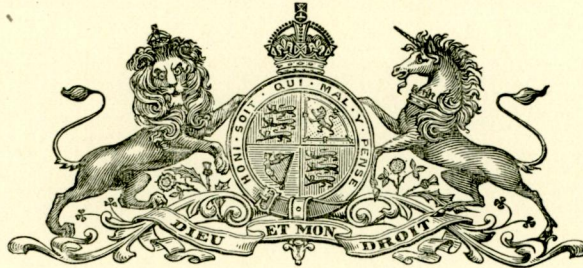

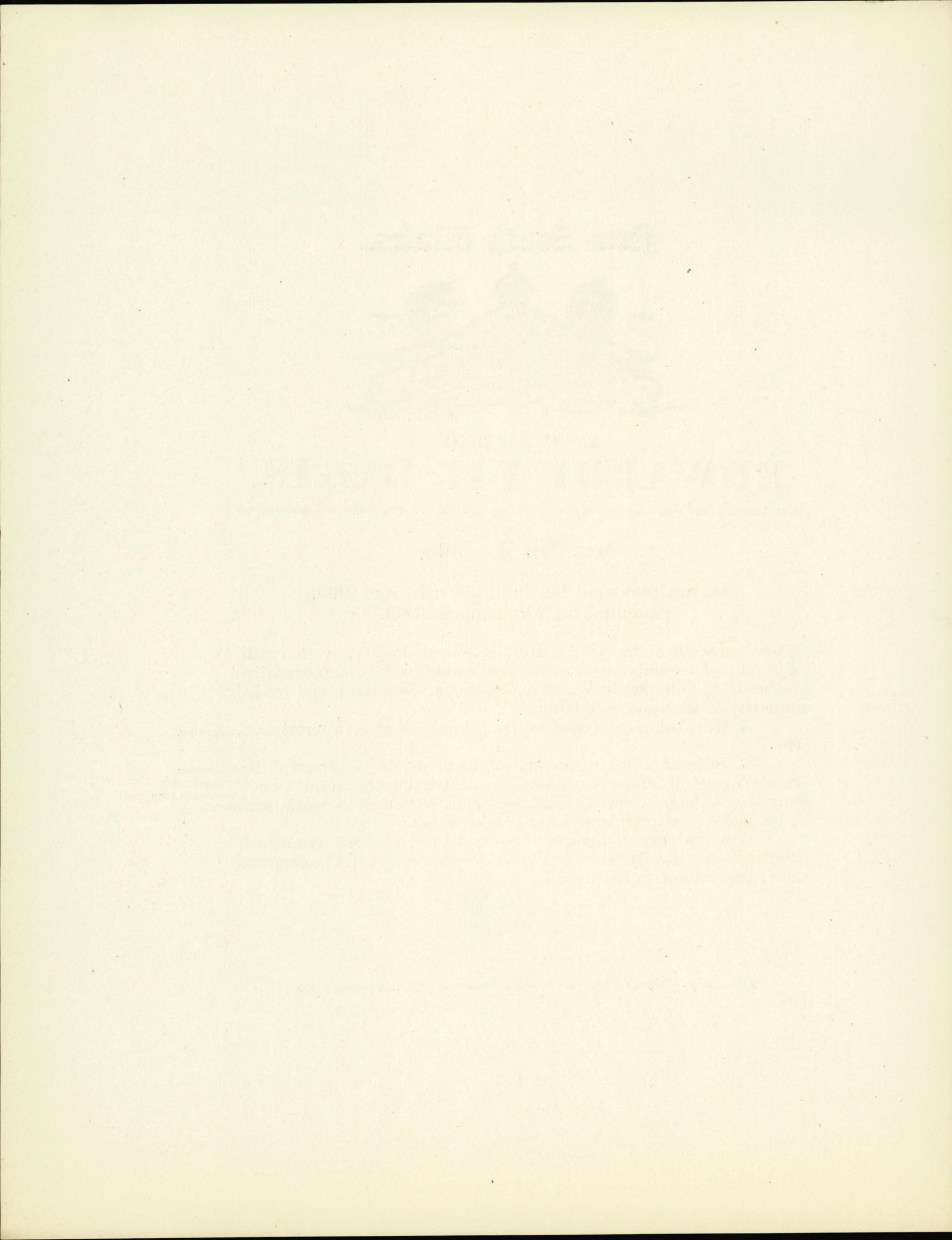
An Act to amend the Public Works Act, 1900.
[Assented to, 6th January, 1908.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Works (Interest) Act, Short title. 1907."

2. Subsection two of section one hundred and nineteen of the Public Works Act, 1900, is amended by substituting the word "four" for the word "six." Such amendment shall be deemed to relate back to the date of the commencement of the said Act. Interest on compensation reduced to four per cent.

Provided that nothing in this section shall affect the case of Bennett versus the Minister for Public Works, or any rights acquired under the decision in that case.

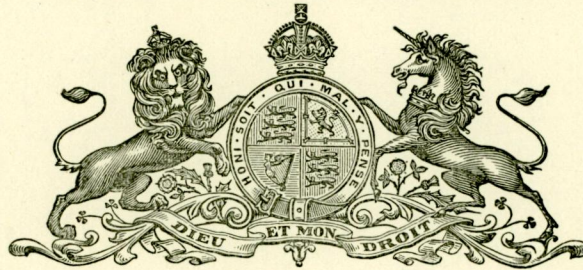

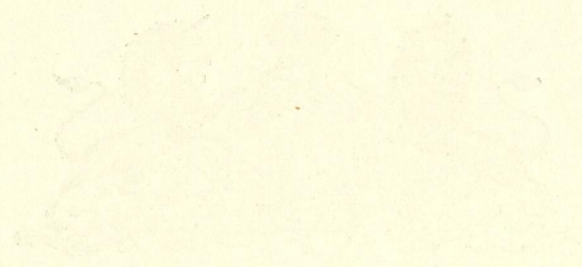
