Act No. 7, 1909.

An Act to provide for the issue of certificates of title to land vested in the Sydney Harbour Trust Commissioners; to amend the Real Property Act, 1900; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to. 11th November, 1909.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Harbour Trust Land short title. Titles Act, 1909."

2. With respect to any land now or hereafter to be vested in Certificate of title the Sydney Harbour Trust Commissioners in any manner referred to in Sydney in section three of this Act, the following provisions shall apply :— Harbour Trust (a) The Registrar-General shall from time to time, on the Commissioners.

(2) Where such certificate of title relates to land resumed by the said Commissioners under the said Act, the land may in such certificate be described in the terms of or by reference to the notice of resumption.

(3) Where such certificate of title relates to land vested by the Governor in the said Commissioners under section twenty-seven of the said Act, the land may in such certificate be described in the terms of, or by reference to, the proclamation notifying such vesting.


