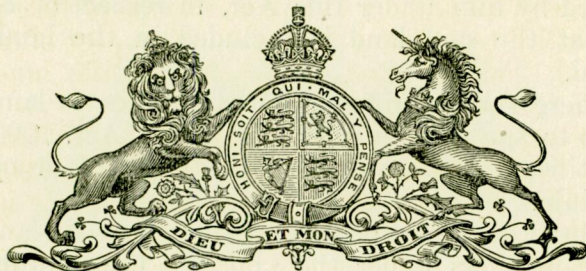

Act No. 7, 1909.

An Act to provide for the issue of certificates of title to land vested in the Sydney Harbour Trust Commissioners; to amend the Real Property Act, 1900; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 11th November, 1909.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Harbour Trust Land Short title. Titles Act, 1909."

2. With respect to any land now or hereafter to be vested in the Sydney Harbour Trust Commissioners in any manner referred to in section three of this Act, the following provisions shall apply:—

(a) The Registrar-General shall from time to time, on the application of the Sydney Harbour Trust Commissioners, issue

issue to the said Commissioners a certificate of title under the Real Property Act, 1900, to all or any part of such land without causing any examination or report to be made as to the title to such land, and without considering such title. No contribution shall be payable under the Nineteenth Schedule to the said Act upon the issue of any such certificate to the assurance fund.

(b) In dealing with such application it shall not be necessary to locate the boundaries of the Crown grants (if any) of any such land, but it shall be sufficient if the Registrar-General is satisfied with respect to any certificate of title proposed to be issued by him under this Act, in respect of any of such land, that the said land is included in the land vested as aforesaid.

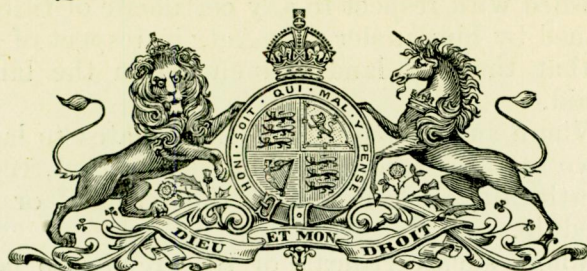

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Harbour Trust Land Titles Act, 1909."

2. With respect to any land now or hereafter to be vested in the Sydney Harbour Trust Commissioners in any manner referred to in section three of this Act, the following provisions shall apply:—

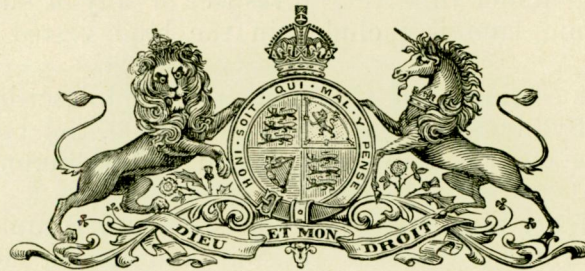

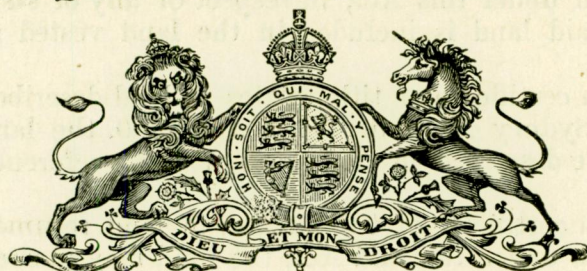
