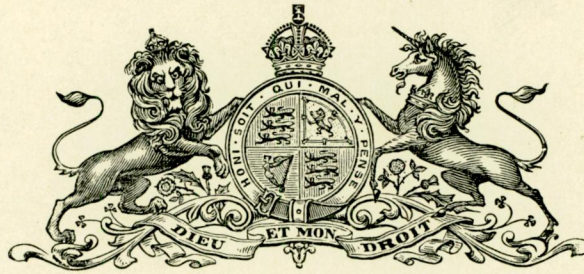

An Act to extend the term of office of the Commissioners of the Western Land Board of New South Wales. [Assented to, 24th December, 1908.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Western Lands Act Amend-Short title.ment Act of 1908," and shall be construed with the Western Lands Acts.

2. The Commissioners of the Western Land Board at the time of the passing of this Act shall, notwithstanding the provisions of section five of the Principal Act, hold office for a further period of twelve months from the expiration of the term of seven years mentioned therein, and any vacancy occurring during such period may be filled up for the unexpired portion thereof. 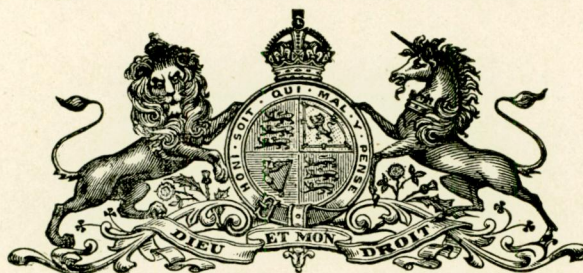

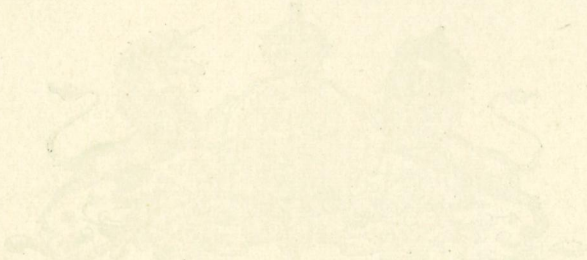

The Commissioners of the Western Land Board at the time the expiration of the period of their term of office shall notwithstanding the provisions of section five of the principal Act hold office for a further period of two months from the expiration of the term of seven years mentioned therein, and any vacancy occurring during such period may be filled up for the unexpired portion thereof.
