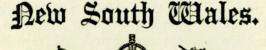

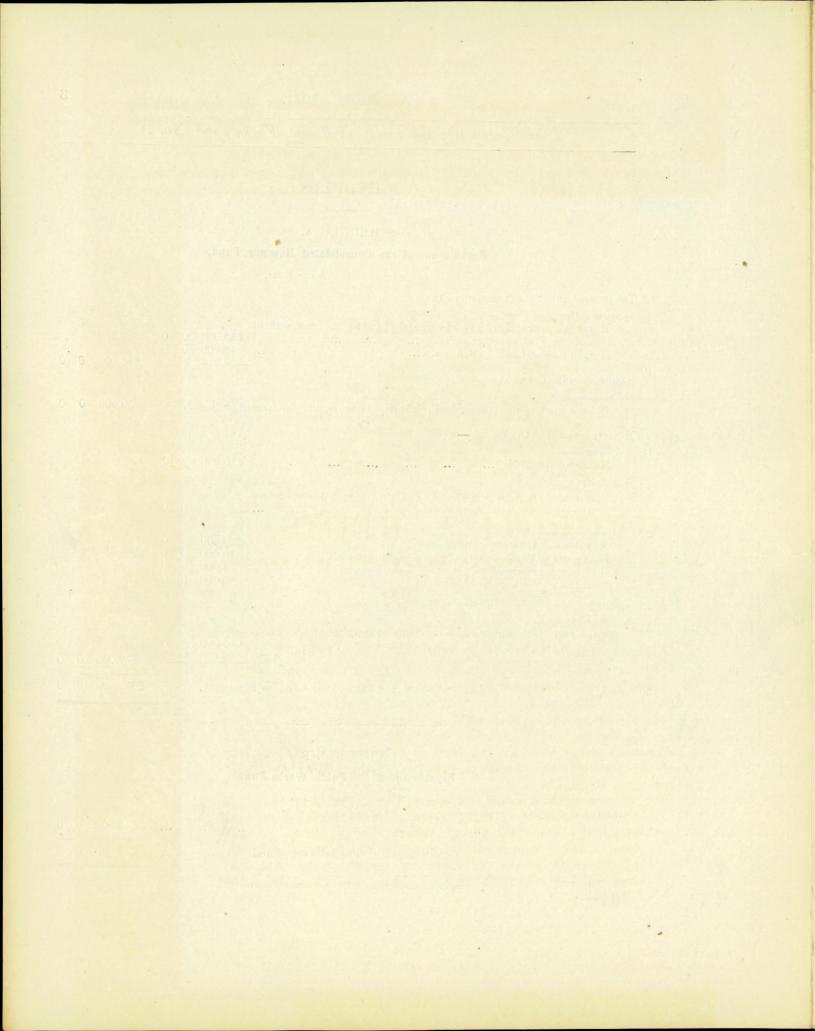

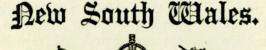

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1911-12; and out of the Public Works Fund; and for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects Preamble. the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of One million one hundred and twenty-three thousand eight 5 hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Eight hundred and ninety-eight thousand eight hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine 414— hundred

hundred and twelve; and the sum of Two hundred and twelve thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Thirteen thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed :

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the 10 Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in

Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-
