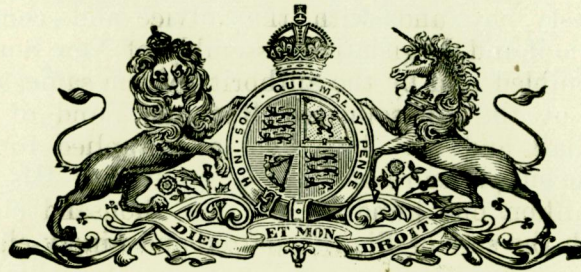
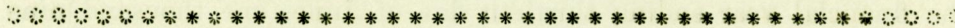

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Eight hundred and ninety-eight thousand eight hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred
