£24,500 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Twenty-four thousand five hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule C hereto annexed.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order. 3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund respectively.
