THEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, Preamble. the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Five millions and twenty-five thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds, that is to say-

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million two hundred and seventy-six thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, and September, or following month of the financial year ending

ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen; and the sum of Two millions one hundred and thirty-five thousand three hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed; and the sum of One million three hundred and eleven thousand nine hundred and fifty pounds for the services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Three hundred and two thousand five hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule C hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said funds the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

£4,723,250 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Four millions seven hundred and twenty-three thousand two hundred and fifty pounds, of which the sum of One million two hundred and seventy-six thousand pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twelve, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, and September, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen. subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1912-1913, and the sum of Two millions one hundred and thirty-five thousand three hundred pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed, and the sum of One million three hundred and eleven thousand nine hundred and fifty pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

£302,500 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Three hundred and two thousand five hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule C hereto annexed.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order. 3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund respectively.

4. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be Treasurer to have allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such credit and receipts to Warrants or Orders. 3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Treasurer to pay 40 Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the under Governor's Warrant or Order. Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works 45 Fund respectively.
