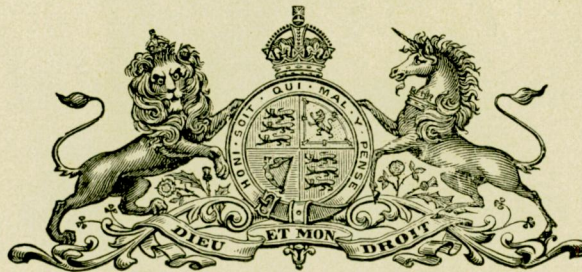

Act No. 4, 1912.

An Act to enable the committee of the Maitland Hospital to withdraw certain moneys from its fixed deposit account for the purpose of erecting and furnishing infectious wards. [Assented to, 2nd April, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Maitland Hospital (Infectious Wards) Enabling Act, 1912." Short title.

2. The committee of the Maitland Hospital may, with the consent of the trustees of the said hospital, or of a majority of them, withdraw a sum of money, not to exceed one thousand five hundred pounds, from the amount in any fixed deposit account standing to its credit or to that of the said trustees at any bank, for the purpose of, and may expend such money in, erecting and furnishing new infectious wards. Authority to committee to withdraw certain moneys from fixed deposits.

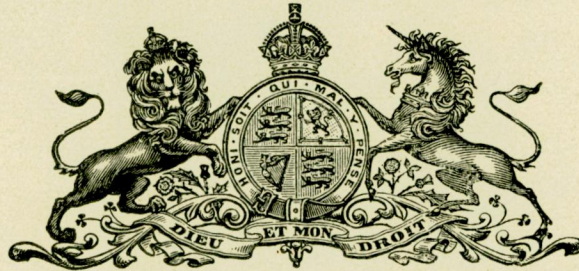

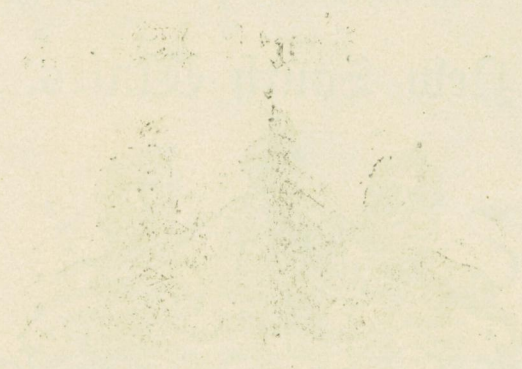

An Act to enable the committee of the Maternity Hospital to withdraw certain moneys from its fund, and to provide for the purpose of working and maintaining the hospital.

A BILL

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Maitland Hospital (Infectious Wards) Enabling Act, 1912." Short title.

10 **2.** The committee of the Maitland Hospital may, with the consent of the trustees of the said hospital, or of a majority of them, withdraw a sum of money, not to exceed one thousand five hundred pounds, from the amount in any fixed deposit account standing to its credit or to that of the said trustees at any bank, for the purpose of, and may expend such money in, erecting and furnishing new infectious wards. Authority to committee to withdraw certain moneys from fixed deposits.

A BILL

To enable the Government of the Malaya States to withdraw certain moneys from the Public Account for the purpose of creating and maintaining infectious wards.

[Enacted by the Malaya States, 1912.]

Enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Assembly of the Malaya States in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the said Majesty, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Malaya States Infectious Wards (Amendment) Act, 1912.

2. The Government of the Malaya States may, with the consent of the Council of the said States, and subject to the approval of the Council of the said States, withdraw a sum of money not exceeding one thousand five hundred pounds from the Public Account for the purpose of creating and maintaining infectious wards, and may expend such moneys in creating and maintaining infectious wards.
