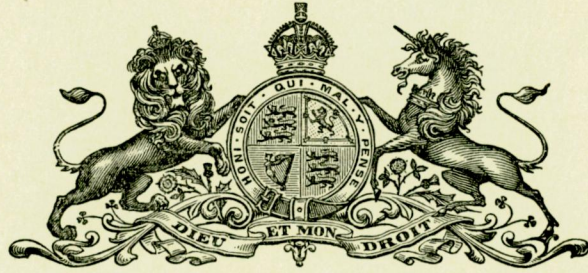

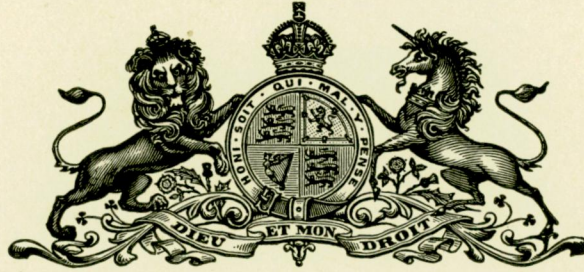

Enacted by His Majesty the King in Council, on the 14th day of August, 1911.

1. The Criminal Code Act, 1900, and the Criminal Code Act, 1905, shall be amended in the manner hereinafter expressed.

2. The words "and the Criminal Code Act, 1905" shall be omitted from section 1 of the Criminal Code Act, 1900.

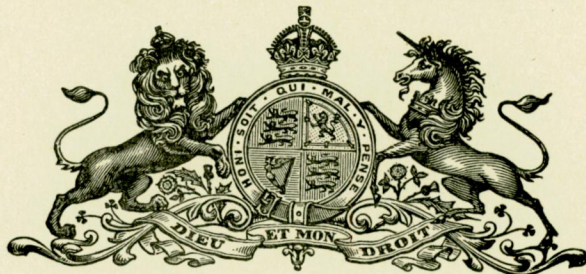
3. The words "and the Criminal Code Act, 1905" shall be omitted from section 2 of the Criminal Code Act, 1900.
