## A BILL

To provide for increased Government representation on the board of directors of the Prince Alfred Hospital; to amend the Prince Alfred Hospital Act, 1902; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5       **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Prince Alfred Hospital Short title.  
(Government Representation) Act, 1912."

**2.** (1) Subsection two of section six of the Prince Alfred Hospital Act, 1902, is amended by the substitution for the words "fifteen" and "three" where they occur in that subsection of the words "twenty-two" and "ten" respectively. Additional Government representation on board.

10       (2) Subsection three of the same section is amended by the substitution for the word "six" of the word "nine."
