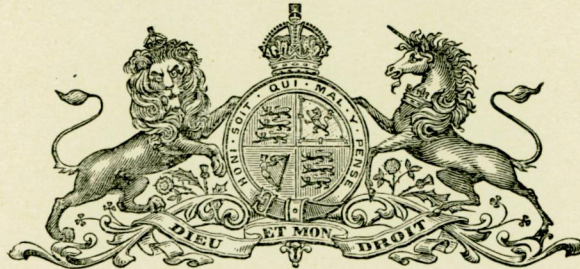

lieu of selling them, lease such lands for any term not exceeding
fifty years, and subject to such conditions and reservations as to

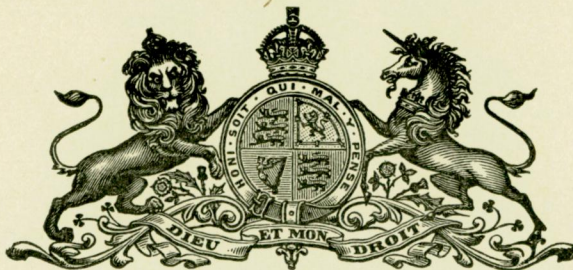

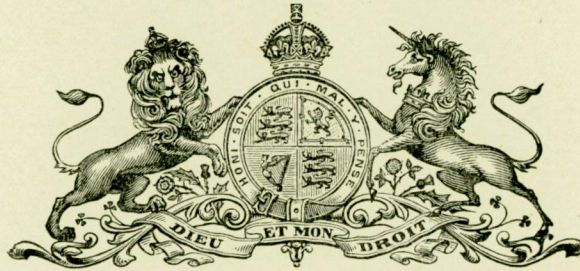
